




## Beijing

## When To Go

Due to its sheer size, China's climate varies greatly throughout the year. Overall, May and October generally have warm days and cool nights making it a pleasant time to travel. The warmest time of the year is from June through to August in central and northern China with increased temperatures and humidity. From December to March, winter brings fewer travellers and possible snowfall in the north. In the south, hot days, cold nights and increased rain occur from April to September while spring and autumn are warm and pleasant, yet can be wet.





Head to Leshan to visit the Giant Buddha and Lingyun Temple, and take boat trip on the Min River. Travel to Mt Emei in the afternoon. Overnight at Century Sunshine Emeishan (or similar). **(B)**

Take a cable car up to Wannian Temple and walk to Qingyin Pavillion and Thin Strip of Sky. Overnight at Chengdu Xinliang Hotel (or similar). **(B)**

The buildings are a blend of Han and Tibetan styles. Move on to the Puning Temple or Temple of Universal Peace, first built in 1775, it's a treasure house of the ancient arts of architecture and sculpture. The Puning Temple also holds the world's tallest wooden sculpture of the Bodhisattva Avalokiteśvara, hence often nicknamed the 'Big Buddha Temple'. After lunch, travel back to Beijing. **(BL)**

# Li River

Cruise through the breathtaking limestone karst scenery of the Li River from Guilin to Yangshuo. Drift slowly and quietly by bamboo raft or take an easy bike ride along the lovely 13 kilometre riverside trail.



# Longsheng

Travel deep into the mountains of Longsheng to see its stunning rice terraces, also known as the 'Dragon's Backbone', and visit local villages to gain an insight into the culture of the Yao ethnic groups.

# Longsheng Day Tour Full Day / Private

#### **From Guilin**

Journey from Guilin past spectacular scenery of towering karst cliff landscapes and ascend the winding road that snakes up the mountainside to Longsheng, an area that is home to various ethnic minority groups.


Wander through the maze of little stone pathways and the traditional Ping'an Village, home to over 80 households who are of Zhuang ethnic minority. The wooden houses on stilts are stacked together. The local Zhuang people maintain their traditions – the men wear handstitched jackets made of cloth and the woman wear white shirts with colourful wraps or scarves on their heads.

Take a short hike further up the mountain from this rice-farming community, to admire some of China's most spectacular rice terrace scenery. This area is known as the Dragon's Backbone due to the amazing rows upon rows of rice terraces clinging precariously to the slopes having the appearance of a dragon's scales. After enjoying the vistas of neighbouring mountain peaks and valleys, travel back to Guilin in the afternoon. **(L)**




# **Giant Pandas**

# Tibet

# When To Go

Tibet's moniker, 'the roof of the world', is a reference to its high altitudes which average 4,000 metres above sea level. Some travellers may suffer altitude sickness but this can be minimised by planning ahead.
