## When To Go

While mostly tropical, Sri Lanka's climate varies between regions. The best period for a round island visit is late January to early April when rainfall is minimal, but the island can be visited year round. Lowland temperatures are pleasant all year, while it is colder in the highlands, especially at night.

- Experience a safari at two of Sri Lanka's best national parks and catch a glimpse of wildlife including leopards, elephants and monkeys.
- Wander through the cobbled streets and admire ancient landmarks in the fortress town of Galle.
- Explore the bustling streets, coastline and aromatic food markets in colourful Colombo.





#### DAY 1 Colombo

On arrival in Colombo, be transferred to your accommodation before exploring the vibrant city on a half day Colombo City Tour. Stroll along the promenade of the Galle Face Green, admire historic buildings and drive past the bustling Pettah Market, Beira Lake and Independence Square. Overnight at Ramada Colombo.

#### DAY 2 Colombo to Udawalawe National Park

Travel south east of Colombo to Udawalawe National Park. The 30,000 hectare park is a sanctuary to native wildlife, including more than 400 elephants. Embark on a safari in the afternoon to spot these majestic beasts, as well as crocodiles, water buffalo, golden jackals and an abundance of bird species. Overnight at Grand Udawalawe Safari Resort. **(B)** 

#### DAY 3 Udawalawe National Park to Yala National Park

Travel to Sri Lanka's most popular park, Yala National Park. Explore the forests, rocky outcrops and grasslands of this diverse park on an afternoon safari. Yala has one of the highest leopard densities in the world so your chances of spotting one are high. You may also catch a glimpse of sloth bears, jungle cats, mongoose, deer, buffalo, crocodiles and elephants, as well as more than 130 species of birds. Stay two nights at Kithala Resort. **(B)** 

#### DAY 4 Yala National Park

After breakfast, explore the national park again on a morning safari. Spend the evening at leisure. **(B)** 

#### DAY 5 Yala National Park to Galle

Journey along the south coast to Galle. Enjoy a walking tour of this historic fortress, exploring cobbled streets and admiring the incredibly well-preserved colonial architecture. Visit the bastions, temples, the Maritime Museum, Government House, and the grand clock tower which dates back to 1707. Stay two nights at Deco on 44. **(B)** 

#### DAY 6 Galle

Spend a day at leisure exploring the restaurants, shops and galleries within the fort walls or watch one of the south coast's brilliant sunsets. **(B)** 

#### DAY 7 Galle to Colombo

On your last day, begin your 2½ hour departure transfer to Colombo airport. **(B)**

### **HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Explore the ancient ruins of Anuradhapura, a sprawling city rich in archaeological and architectural wonders and see the world's oldest living tree.
- Climb to the top of Sigiriya and take in the spectacular panoramic views.
- Visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic in Kandy which houses the tooth of the Buddha.

#### DAY 1 Colombo to Negombo

On arrival in Colombo, be transferred to your beachside hotel in nearby Negombo. Overnight at Camelot Beach Hotel.

#### DAY 2 Negombo to Sigiriya

Journey to the 4th century BC capital, Anuradhapura. Enjoy an afternoon wandering through the ancient city ruins, taking in ancient pools, crumbling temples and giant dagobos, second in size to the pyramids of Egypt. Visit the 2,300-year-old sacred Bo tree, Sri Maha Bodhi, the oldest documented living tree in the world and one of the earliest symbols of Buddhism. Stay two nights at Hotel Sigiriya. **(B)** 

#### DAY 3 Sigiriya

Travel to the base of Sigiriya rock, the 5th century AD rock fortress of King Kasyapa. As you climb the stairs to the top, marvel at the ancient art, stone sculptures and frescoes. Wander through the ruins and take in the spectacular views of the surrounding countryside from the summit of the rock. If you choose not to climb, explore the beautiful gardens and ruins around the base of the rock. It's not hard to see why this spot is Sri Lanka's most popular attraction. **(B)** 

#### DAY 4 Sigiriya to Kandy

En route to Kandy, stop at the Dambulla Cave Temple. The hilltop temple complex consists of five caves that have been converted to shrines. The temples offer spectacular views from the top and are filled with an array of Buddha statues and paintings. Visit a spice garden and learn more about the island's famous produce. Stay two nights at Hotel Suisse. **(B)** 

#### **DAY 5 Kandy**

Discover Kandy's highlights on a half day city tour. Visit the upper lake, gem museum and Peradeniya Botanical Gardens. Afterwards, visit the Dalada Maligawa – Kandy's revered Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic. **(B)** 

#### DAY 6 Kandy to Colombo

Venture from Kandy to Colombo, the country's capital. In the afternoon, experience the hustle and bustle of the commercial area of Fort and drive past the noisy bazaar area of Pettah or Pitakotuwa. Visit the Wolvendaal Dutch Church, built in 1749, and drive through Cinnamon Gardens. Overnight at OZO Colombo. **(B)**

#### DAY1 Colombo

On arrival in Colombo, be transferred to your hotel. Stay the next two nights at OZO Colombo.

#### DAY 2 Colombo

Discover the fascinating sites of Colombo as you take a half day tour through the commercial area of Fort, the noisy bazaar of Pettah or Pitakotuwa and the Wolvendaal Dutch Church. Drive through Cinnamon Gardens, Colombo's upmarket residential area. **(B)** 

#### DAY 3 Colombo to Kandy

En route to Kandy, visit a spice garden and learn about the incredible range of spices grown in Sri Lanka's rich tropical hills. In the afternoon, visit the Dalada Maligawa – the famous Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, one of Buddhism's holiest sites. Be entertained by drummers, dancers and fire walkers at a local cultural show. Stay three nights at Hotel Suisse. **(B)** 

#### DAY 4 Kandy

Discover the inland cultural hub of Kandy on a full day city tour. Visit Kandy Lake, a beautiful man-made lake in the heart of the city, explore

a gem museum and visit a busy market. In the afternoon, take a relaxing stroll through the Peredeniya Botanical Gardens. The stunning 60-hectare gardens have a vast collection of orchids, palms and local wildlife. **(B)** 

#### **DAY 5 Kandy**

Venture to a picturesque hillside tea plantation and factory to see how the aromatic Ceylon tea is grown. Visit the Ceylon Tea Museum in Hantane and learn about the 130-year history of the robust tea industry in Sri Lanka. **(B)** 

#### DAY 6 Kandy to Galle

Travel to the ancient fort town of Galle. Take a guided half day walking tour through the 17th century fortress and enjoy its charming cobbled streets and heritage buildings. Stay two nights at The Fort Printers. **(B)**

#### DAY 1 Colombo to Negombo

Venture into the Cultural Triangle, stopping en route at the Dambulla Cave Temple, a gallery of Buddhist art set in a series of hilltop caves. Settle into your beautiful resort-style accommodation nestled around a series of lakes. Stay two nights at Water Garden Resort. **(B)** 

#### DAY 3 Sigiriya Rock & Minneriya National Park

Drive to nearby Sigiriya, Sri Lanka's most iconic attraction. This dramatic rock fortress shelters some fine religious and royal artworks and architecture. Those fit enough to climb the 2,000 plus stairs to the top will enjoy sweeping views. Wander through the ancient ruins of the city that was. Go on a jeep safari through Minneriya National Park where you may catch a glimpse of Asian elephants. **(B)** 

#### DAY 4 Sigiriya to Kandy

Journey up to the highlands and learn about Sri Lanka's thriving horticultural industry at a spice and fruit farm. In the afternoon, explore Kandy's botanical gardens and visit one of the most important Buddhist artefacts at the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic. Overnight at Stone House. **(B)** 

#### DAY 5 Kandy to Hatton

Travel by train across the highlands, enjoying fine tea and views of lush green plantations wrapping around hills in the countryside. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure. Overnight at Hatton Bungalows by letwing. **(B)** 

#### **DAY 6 Hatton to Galle**

Discover a local tea estate and factory. Learn about the tea-growing history and processes, and sample some local varieties. Travel to the south coast and historic Galle Fort. Stay two nights at The Fort Printers. **(B)** 

#### DAY 7 Galle

Spend the day exploring the ancient seaside fortress. Take a guided walk along the cobbled streets lined with historic landmarks and colonial architecture that has been perfectly preserved throughout the centuries. Settle by the shore as the sun goes down to take in the fabulous colours of a famous south coast sunset. **(B)**

Enjoy the entertaining Kandy Cultural Show and visit the Dalada Maligawa – Kandy's revered Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, home to one of the world's holiest Buddha relics. Stay two nights at Suisse Hotel. **(B)**

Discover Kandy on a full day city tour including the upper lake, gem museum and beautiful Peradeniya Botanical Gardens. **(B)**

View the spectacular views from the Sigiriya ancient rock fortress summit. Visit ruins and historic sculptures in the ancient city of Polonnaruwa. Explore the hilltop Dambulla Cave Temple. **(2B)** 

#### DAYS 6-7 Sigiriya to Kandy

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Journey into the hills to Kandy. Attend a cultural show and visit the iconic Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic. Visit a colourful marketplace, the lake circuit and the Royal Botanical Gardens. Stay two nights at Suisse Hotel. **(2B)** 

#### DAY 8 Kandy to Nuwara Eliya

Enjoy a scenic drive through Hill Country to Nuwara Eliya stopping at a tea plantation and factory. Overnight at Araliya Green Hills Hotel. **(B)**
