



WHAT TO EXPECT

Embark on a remarkable 10-day group journey to uncover the treasures of Israel. Begin with leisurely exploration of vibrant Tel Aviv, immersing yourself in the city's unique atmosphere and staying at a picturesque Kibbutz. Delve into the ancient wonders and profound religious sites of Jerusalem, where history comes alive at every corner. Indulge in a rejuvenating swim in the legendary Dead Sea and pamper yourself with the mineral-rich mud. This extraordinary experience promises unforgettable moments and memories.

Day 1: Arrival in Tel Aviv

Welcome to Israel! Upon arrival in Tel Aviv make your way to the selected hotel (private airport transfer not included) and enjoy the rest of the day free for own leisure. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

Day 2: Tel Aviv

Spend a day at leisure, relaxing and discover the vibrant city of Tel Aviv at your own pace. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

Day 3: Caesarea - Megiddo - Druze village - Haifa

Drive along the coastal plain to Caesarea, once the Roman capital of the region; see the excavations of the Crusaderera city, the Roman port, aqueduct and the amphitheatre that has been restored to its former glory as a concert venue. Proceed to Megiddo, identified as the site of Armageddon; visit the archaeological excavations including the well-preserved water supply system. Continue to Daliat el-Carmel, a Druze village and enjoy a late lunch at a local restaurant. Proceed via Mount Carmel to Haifa for a panoramic view of the Haifa bay and the Golden domed Bahai Shrine and gardens. Overnight and dinner in a Kibbutz guesthouse.

- Insider Experiences: Visit of Caesarea, Visit of the archaeological excavations of Megiddo, Panoramic view of the Haifa bay

Day 4: Safed - Katzrin - Golan winery

Drive to Safed, the center of Jewish mysticism; Visit the ancient synagogues and the Artists' colony. Continue to the Golan Heights to see the former Syrian bunkers, Quneitra and the new Israeli town of Katzrin. Stop at the Golan Winery for a tour and wine tasting; Proceed to "Golan Magic" for a multimedia presentation of the area and its history. Overnight and dinner in a Kibbutz guesthouse.

- Insider Experiences: Visit of the ancient synagogues of Safed, Visit of the Artists' colony in Safed, Visit of the Golan Heights, Taste Visit of the Golan Winery and wine tasting

Day 5: Sea of Galilee - Nazareth - Beit Alpha

Start the day with a visit to Nazareth; Visit the Church of Annunciation; Continue to Tiberias; Visit Capernaum to see the ruins of the synagogue and octagonal Church of St. Peter; Visit Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the sermon on the mount. Drive via Beit Shean to Beit Alpha to see the remains of the mosaic floor of an ancient synagogue depicting the zodiac. Overnight in Jerusalem.

- Insider Experiences: Visit of Nazareth, Visit of Capernaum, Visit of the Mount of Beatitudes, Stop at Beit Alpha

Day 6: Mt. of Olives - Old City - Bethlehem

Start the day with a magnificent panoramic view from Mount of Olives. Drive to the Old City; Visit the Tomb of King David and the Room of Last Supper on Mt. Zion. Enter the walled city and walk through the newly restored Jewish quarter. Visit the Roman Cardo, the Herodian quarter and continue to the Western Wall. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of Holy Sepulchre. Continue to Bethlehem*; view Rachel's Tomb and proceed to visit the Church of Nativity and Manger's Square. Overnight in Jerusalem.

- Insider Experiences: Panoramic view from Mount of Olives, Spiritual Visit of the Old City of Jerusalem

Day 7: Israel museum - Knesset - Mt. Herzl - Yad Vashem

Drive to the Israel Museum; Visit the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and the miniature model of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period; Proceed for a tour at the Knesset, Israel's parliament. Continue to visit Mount Herzl cemetery and Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the Holocaust. Drive through Mea Shearim, the ultra orthodox neighbourhood in Jerusalem and learn about their unique lifestyle. In the evening enjoy a middle eastern dinner followed by the spectacular "Sound & David Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem.

- Insider Experiences: Visit of the Shrine of the Book, Visit of the Knesset, Israel's parliament, Visit of Mount
 Herzl cemetery and Yad Vashem, Israel's official memorial to the Holocaust, Arts & Craft "Sound & Light" show
 at the Tower of David Museum

Day 8: Qumran- Masada - Dead Sea

Drive through the Judaean Desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, almost 1300 feet (400 meters) below sea level. Stop at Qumran to visit the site where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada. Ascend by cable car and tour the ancient fortress where the Zealots made their last stand against the Romans before committing mass suicide in 73 AD. Descend by cable car. Continue to the Dead Sea; cover yourself with the mineral rich mud and experience a swim in the Dead Sea* that many believe offers therapeutic effects. Overnight in Jersualem.

Day 9: Jerusalem

Enjoy a day free for own leisure and discover more of Jerusalem at your own pace. Overnight in Jerusalem.
